# General Terms, Conditions, & Guidelines

## **The Fourth Annual Hanover Day Art Exhibit**

at the Frame Center, 152 Rockland St., Hanover, MA

Exhibition Dates: Tuesday, June 18-- Friday July 26, 2019

Artists' Awards Reception: Thursday, June 20, 2019, 6-8 pm

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all artists. Artists may submit up to two pieces of original artwork completed within the last 5 years.

**AWARDS:** Cash Awards will be given for First Prize in each category to the artist who displays excellence in their medium. Categories include: B&W and Color Photography, Drawing, Oil and Acrylic Painting, Watercolor, Mixed Media and 3D. A special "Hanover Excellence Award" will be given to an artist from Hanover, or one who depicts a Hanover-related scene or theme in their work.

**JURYING PROCESS:** Guest Jurors: Marcia Ballou and Patricia Walsh Slaven will select works of merit in each category to receive a first prize cash award and subsequent awards, as they deem appropriate for second and third place ribbons.

### **ENTRY PROCEDURE:**

Artwork must be dropped off at the Frame Center, located at 152 Rockland Street, Hanover on

**\*\*Saturday, June 1 from 10:00 am - 1:00pm, or Tuesday, June 4 from 2:00 - 5:00pm. Artwork will not be accepted by Frame Center Staff. If you need to arrange an alternate time for drop-off, please contact Karen Cass: (617)388-4427\*\*.**

A completed, signed, registration form and \$10.00 cash entry fee must accompany each piece of artwork. Each piece of work must include the artist's full name clearly attached to/written on the back of the work.

**\*\*FRAMING:** All work must be received ready for installation. Artwork should be securely framed and wired. Please note that The Frame Center has an extensive collection of high-quality and very reasonably priced moldings and ready-made frames that are expertly built and fitted to your artwork. Make arrangements prior to the exhibit to have your work framed! A special award will be provided by the Frame Center for "Best Frame". Clamped glass or sawtooth hangers are not considered acceptable preparations for hanging. Artwork deemed unsuitable for hanging/installation may be rejected from the exhibit\*\*.

\*The maximum size of artwork is 36" in each direction. Overweight 2D work must be accompanied by a sturdy easel, provided by the artist.

Sculpture and 3-dimensional work must be accompanied by a sturdy pedestal.

Pick up of work is Saturday, July 27 or Monday, July 29, 2019 from 10:00 am – 5:00 pm.

**The Frame Center and the Hanover Cultural Council accept no responsibility for work that is not retrieved by the deadline. After 30 days, artwork may be discarded.**

**SALES:** \*\*A commission of 20% will be charged. Artists are responsible for paying the 20% commission fee directly to The Frame Center for work that is sold through the **Hanover Day Art Exhibit**. Work need not be for sale.

**LIABILITY:** Great care will be taken with all artwork. However, artists are responsible for insuring their own pieces and equipment. The Frame Center, The Hanover Cultural Council and any volunteers or staff involved in preparing the exhibit may not be held responsible for any loss or damage to artwork or equipment.
